Foreword

The contents of this handbook will inform parents/ carers, teachers and students about Belmont State School's iPad program. All information is correct at the time of printing, however as technology continues to evolve, this handbook is open to review to stay responsive to the needs of our students and community.

Belmont State School will:

- ✓ provide all school apps for all students.
- ✓ use the Department of Education's, *Intune* mobile device management (MDM) for all devices.
- ✓ continue to supply **shared** equity devices to ensure every student has access to a device.

Parents / Carers will:

- ✓ **NOT** be required to purchase any school apps.
- ✓ supply an iPad for your student to use.
- ✓ download and enrol your student into **Intune**.
- ✓ set up your student's iPad as per the instructions in this handbook.

All students **MUST** be enrolled into *Intune* to access Wi-Fi and all Apps provided by Belmont State School.

VISION

To foster a school community that utilises a technologically enhanced environment where students are equipped with the skills and confidence for the 21st century.



iPAD AND THE CURRICULUM

The iPad is used at Belmont State School in a way that considers students' individual learning requirements and health and safety across a balanced curriculum. Student learning is enhanced with the use of their iPad along with school books and pencils.

The iPad supports the fundamental early years' experiences that students require to develop fine, gross motor and social skills. With our balanced curriculum, the iPad is an important tool for teachers to implement 21st century learning experiences, by giving added voice and choice for a learner-centered teaching approach.

The Apple Helpline is available 24/7 on 1300 321 456 to support the setup of everything within the Settings App, however are unable to support with Microsoft Intune.

Start of year procedures:

Day 1

- Students WILL NOT use an iPad at school on Day 1.
- They will learn about iPad rules, responsibilities and expectations.

Day 2 onwards

- Teacher will notify when, BYO students can bring their iPad to school.
- School shared devices will be distributed **from** Week 2.



2024 Device Requirements

Purchasing a new iPad

There are 4 current models to choose from:

- iPad 9th gen
- iPad 10th gen
- iPad Pro 11"
- iPad Pro 12.5"



NOTE: Upon release, the iPad 11th Gen model will become a suitable option. iPad mini is unsuitable for school.

Using an existing iPad

An existing iPad must:

- Run iPadOS 17
- Minimum 64GB
- Wi-Fi iPad (if supplying a cellular iPad, remove the SIM for school)



NOTE: Refer to Apple Support to find if the existing iPad can run iPadOS17 <http://apple.co/2qXVG6P>

Protective case

The iPad must have a sturdy case with an added front screen cover.

The following brands are sturdy and do not obstruct the headphone jack, volume control and camera: STM Dux, Zagg Rugged, *Gumdrop*, *Griffin Survivor* or *OtterBox*.



NOTE: Novelty cases do not provide effective protection for your student's iPad and may obstruct the headphone jack, volume control and camera.

Headphones

Students must have over the head, headphones with built in microphone which is included on all booklists.

The headphones on the booklist are **not** suitable for **iPad 10th gen** and **iPad Pros** as those iPads do not have a headphone jack. Your student will need either:

- USB-C headphones **or**
- Bluetooth headphones **or**
- Lightning/USB-C to 3.5mm Headphone Jack Adapter <http://shorturl.at/jkpB2>



NOTE: it is important to check that any headphones you purchase are compatible with the device and that the case you purchase is not blocking the headphone port.

Stylus

The following stylus brands are recommended for your student:

- Apple Pencil
- Zagg Pro Stylus



NOTE: These stylus options are available to purchase through the JB Hi-Fi Education Solutions Portal. Ensure the stylus you choose is compatible with the iPad model you have.

Keyboard

A Bluetooth keyboard is optional.

Travelling to and from school




The waterproof, Belmont carry bags or a neoprene zip sleeve are recommended to transport the iPad within student's school bag.

• Using an existing iPad, please follow Steps 6 - 9. • Setting up a new iPad, go to step 10.	
6. Repair any damages to the iPad, including cracked screens and cases.	
7. Update your student's iPad to the latest operating system, ie, iPadOS 17.	
8. Delete unwanted photos/ videos.	
9. Delete school content that is no longer required in Book Creator, Keynote, Pages, Clips and GarageBand.	
10. Add a Lock Screen Passcode Settings > General > <i>Touch ID & Passcode</i> > Turn Passcode On > Passcode Options (optional 4-digit numeric code or a 6-digit code) Note: This is a Department of Education Intune requirement Teach your student this passcode and provide to your student's teacher on Day 1.

Intune Information

Intune Information

The Department of Education utilises Microsoft Intune, as the mobile device management platform for BYO iPads. All BYO iPads must be enrolled into Microsoft Intune to:



- access the secured, school Wi-Fi network.
- receive all school learning apps for free.

3rd Party VPN Software

Some parental filtering apps may include a VPN as part of their installation for the purpose of re-routing internet traffic through their filtering service. In the past, these services have inadvertently blocked internet traffic on the student device due to incompatibility with our network. They must be removed or disabled during school hours for students to access the Wi-Fi and receive apps.


The use of 3rd party VPN software for the purpose of circumventing departmental internet filtering on the Education QLD network is prohibited and in violation of our acceptable use policy.

iPad Terms of Use and Participation Agreement

Taking care of my iPad

I understand it is my responsibility to:

- Make sure my iPad is in my bag when I go to and from school.
- Keep my iPad away from food and drink at all times.
- Keep my iPad on a table or in my lap.
- Keep my iPad in the classroom at all break times unless directed by a teacher.
- Keep my iPad, stylus, keyboard and headphones safe, and in good working order.
- Walk and carry my iPad with two hands.

For my learning

I will:

- Bring my iPad to school every day with 100% battery.
- Only use **School Apps** at school, even during wet weather lunch breaks.
- Select **Always Allow**, when my teacher enrolls me into their **Classroom App**.
- Always enable **Wi-Fi**, **Bluetooth** and **Airdrop** whilst at school.
- Set up a **School Focus** to prevent notifications coming through between 8:50am – 2:50pm from non- school apps: Entertainment, Gaming and Social Networking apps, including iMessages.
- Only have age-appropriate apps on my iPad (E.g. If you are 9-years old, you will only have Apps suitable for a 9-year old).
- Not install social media, games or entertainment content on my iPad if the age limit for these Apps is 12+. These are, but not limited to Apps such as Facebook, Messenger, Snapchat, BeReal, Instagram, Tik Tok, Roblox, Fortnite or other Apps.

For my safety and security

I will:

- Leave other students' iPad and profiles alone.
- Immediately report any accidents or breakages to my teacher and parents/ carers.
- Only use my school email, Seesaw and OneNote accounts for educational purposes directly related to learning.
- Only take photos, videos or voice memos on my iPad when instructed by my teacher.
- Not share my full name, personal details, images of myself or others, my school uniform or logo, videos or voice memos to any internet site, social media App or distribute them in any way unless it is safe, and I have asked for permission.
- Not share account names and passwords with anyone unless requested by my teacher and parents/ carers.
- Leave my SIM card at home if I have a cellular iPad.

I understand that if I do not meet these conditions the following may occur:

- My parents may be notified by my class teacher.
- I may lose the privilege of using my iPad at school for the session, day, week or longer.
- I will be required to complete my usual work using alternative strategies.
- I may be subject to disciplinary action according to the Student Code of Conduct.
